AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FOREST HEIGHTS, MARYLAND AMENDING ARTICLE 15 (PARKING AND TRAFFIC), SECTION 15.6 (SPEED MONITORING SYSTEMS), BY STRIKING THE CIVIL PENALTY AND RETURNED CHECK FEE PROVI-SIONS AND PLACING THEM IN SECTION 15.9 (PENALTIES); AND BY AMENDING AND RENAMING SECTION 15.9 (PENALTIES), BY PLACING THE WORDS "AND FEES" IN THE CATCHLINE, AND BY INCREASING THE CIVIL PENALTY FOR A SPEED CAMERA VIOLATION FROM \$35 TO \$40 AS PERMITTED BY STATE LAW; AND BY FURTHER AMENDING SECTION 15.9 BY ALLOWING CERTAIN FEES RELATING TO ENFORCEMENT OF VIOLA-TIONS UNDER ARTICLE 15 (PARKING AND TRAFFIC); AND BY AUTHORIZ-ING THE COUNCIL TO ESTABLISH FROM TIME TO TIME BY RESOLUTION CERTAIN FINES, FEES, AND CHARGES AUTHORIZED BY AND RELATING TO SAID ARTICLE, AND BY MAKING CERTAIN STYLISTIC AND GRAMMATI-CAL CHANGES WITHIN ARTICLE 15, AND GENERALLY RELATING TO THE REGULATION AND CONTROL OF PARKING AND TRAFFIC.
