TOWN OF FOREST HEIGHTS NOTICE OF A PROPOSED REAL PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The Town Council of the Town of Forest Heights proposes to increase real property taxes.

- 1. For the tax year beginning July 1, 2012, the estimated real property assessable base will increase by 1.4% from \$151,132,782 to \$153,185,394.
- 2. If the Town of Forest Heights maintains the current tax rate of \$0.5671 per \$100 of the assessment, real property tax revenues will increase by 1.4% resulting in \$11,640 of new real property tax revenues.
- 3. In order to fully offset the effect of increasing assessments, the real property tax rate should be reduced to \$0.5595, the constant yield tax rate.
- 4. The Town of Forest Heights is considering not reducing its real property tax rate enough to fully offset increasing assessments. The town proposes to adopt a real property tax rate of \$0.6248 per \$100 of assessment. This tax rate is 11.7% higher than the constant yield tax rate and will generate \$100,030 in additional property tax revenues.

A public hearing on the proposed real property tax rate increase will be held at 6:30 P.M. on **May 23, 2012** at the Municipal Building, 5508 Arapahoe Dr. in Forest Heights, MD.
