**A RESOLUTION TO PURCHASE A LEAF COLLECTOR FOR THE PUBLIC
WORKS DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, the Council finds that it is prudent, urgent and necessary to expeditiously procure leaf collector for the Public Works Department; and

WHEREAS, the funds are available under line item 8000 (Street Repair Project) and it has been determined by Council that the company, L.J. Elter & Son of Huntingtown, MD is a Maryland company in good standing with the State of Maryland and said company is further found to be a substantially unique provider of this merchandise or service, and the procurement is for items of a specialized nature in accordance with Section 20.4(a)(6) of the Ordinance Code for the Town of Forest Heights.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Town Council of The Town of Forest Heights, Maryland hereby authorize the Public Works Supervisor or his designee to purchase (1) leaf collector (TRAC VAC Model 288 Leaf Trailer) from said vendor at a rate purchase not to exceed \$12,789.95 total as further described in a detailed purchase order and discounted pricing breakdown of (Attachment #1).

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect upon its passage.






