A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FOREST HEIGHTS, MARYLAND TO HIRE RICARDO SMITH AS A FULL TIME CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER FOR THE TOWN OF FOREST HEIGHTS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 33-66 of the Charter of the Town of Forest Heights (the “Charter”) the Council shall hire employee and;

WHEREAS, the Council finds that Ricardo Smith, has the necessary experience and knowledge to serve a full time Code Enforcement Officer with the Town of Forest Heights and it is in the best interest of the Town to hire Mr. Smith; and

WHEREAS, Ricardo Smith, will served in the capacity as code enforcement officer with the Town, at the agreed upon salary written in his offer letter and will become a full-time employee with all the benefits offered to full time employees of the town;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Council hereby authorizes Mayor to hire Mr. Ricardo as a full-time Code Enforcement Officer; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said officer’s salary shall be paid from line item 7056 Salary – Code Enforcement Officer of the FY2015 budget

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
