**A RESOLUTION TO TRANSFER FUNDS BETWEEN APPROPRIATIONS IN
FY 2015 BUDGET**

ENACTED:

WHEREAS, Section 33-46 of the Charter of the Town of Forest Heights states that no money may be expended without having been appropriated by the Council; and

WHEREAS, Section 33-47 of the Charter of the Town of Forest Heights states that any transfer of funds between major appropriations for different purposes by the Mayor must be approved by the Council before becoming effective; and

WHEREAS, Section 33-48 of the Charter of the Town of Forest Heights forbids the over expenditure of appropriated or transferred funds; and

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED, that line item 6108 Chesapeake Bay Trust - Treekeepers Grant be added to the Revenue section of the budget in the amount of \$44,815. and that line item 8040 Chesapeake Bay Trust - Treekeepers Grant be added to the Expense section of the budget in the amount of \$44,815, and that line item 6023 Highway User Fund be increased by \$43,755, that line item 6037 Speed Camera Fund be increased in the amount of 165,000 and that line item 6094 Speed Camera Fund – Collections be increased in the amount of 95,000 in the Revenue section of the budget and that the offset be to line item 7300 Speed Camera – Administration Fee in the amount of \$166,000 and to line item 8034 Rolph Drive Project in the amount of 137,755 in the Expense section of the budget.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
