**A RESOLUTION TO ADJUST FUNDS BETWEEN APPROPRIATIONS IN
FY15 BUDGET**

ENACTED:

WHEREAS, Section 33-46 of the Charter of the Town of Forest Heights states that no money may be expended without having been appropriated by the Council; and

WHEREAS, Section 33-47 of the Charter of the Town of Forest Heights states that any transfer of funds between major appropriations for different purposes by the Mayor must be approved by the Council before becoming effective; and

WHEREAS, Section 33-48 of the Charter of the Town of Forest Heights forbids the over expenditure of appropriated or transferred funds; and

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED, that funds be increased for line item 6112 LGIT Body Camera Grant and line item 7175 Surveillance Cameras in the amount of \$1,750, and that funds be decreased for line item 6106 Chesapeake Bay Trust – Rolph Drive and line item 8023 Chesapeake Bay Trust in the amount of \$202,490, and line item 6080 NFWF Rolph Drive and line item 7236 NFWF Urban Small Waters in the amount of \$40,000, and line item 6084 PG Co. Stormwater Maintenance and line item 8034 Rolph Drive Project in the amount of \$64,551, and line item 6102 MD Smart Energy Grant and line item 7258 MD Smart Energy Grant in the amount of \$80,000 and line item 6108 Chesapeake Bay Trust – Treekeepers and line item 8040 Chesapeake Bay Trust - Treekeepers in the amount of \$43,815.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
