**A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT THE PUBLIC ASSISTANCE GRANT FROM THE
MARYLAND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY FOR THE TOWN OF
FOREST HEIGHTS**

WHEREAS, the Maryland Emergency Management Agency (MEMA) agreed to provide the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Public Assistance Program funding to eligible Subrecipients under Disaster Number: FEMA-4261-DR, Maryland Disaster Declaration as of March 4, 2016; and

WHEREAS, The Town of Forest Heights applied for participation as a Subrecipient on March 24, 2016 in the State of Maryland Public Assistance Program and was awarded acceptance, and became eligible for the reimbursement for this grant of the 75% Federal Share of the projects Eligible Costs resulting from the 2016 Snowstorm; and

WHEREAS, FEMA has reviewed and approved Project Worksheet PW#176 submitted by the Town of Forest Heights, the payment for this grant is \$25,176.40; and

BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Town Council of The Town of Forest Heights, Maryland hereby agrees to accept the Public Assistance Grant from the Maryland Emergency Management Agency in the amount of \$25,176.40 for FY2016;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the \$25,176.40 be allocated to line item 6048 MEMA Grant of the FY2016 Budget;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
