WHEREAS, Playful Cities USA is a national recognition program sponsored by KaBOOM! that honors communities across the country for taking action locally to build an infrastructure that promotes, creates and sustains an abundance of time and space for play for all children and adults; and

WHEREAS, a municipality must meet the following core set of commitments to become nationally recognized as a Playful City: 1) Create a local play board, task force and/or commission; 2) Design an annual action plan for Play; 3) Conduct a Play space audit; 4) Outline its financial investment in Play; and 5) Proclaim and celebrate an annual "Play Day;" and

WHEREAS, the Town of Forest Heights ("Town") believes that it can meet these core commitments, and desires to submit an application to become one of the founding Playful Cities in the recognition program;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FOREST HEIGHTS THAT:

The Mayor is authorized to execute and submit an application on behalf of the Town of Forest Heights to participate in the Playful City USA recognition program sponsored by KaBOOM!






