**A RESOLUTION TO TRANSFER FUNDS BETWEEN APPROPRIATIONS IN FY14  
BUDGET**

**ENACTED:**

**WHEREAS**, Section 33-46 of the Charter of the Town of Forest Heights states that no money may be expended without having been appropriated by the Council; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 33-47 of the Charter of the Town of Forest Heights states that any transfer of funds between major appropriations for different purposes by the Mayor must be approved by the Council before becoming effective; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 33-48 of the Charter of the Town of Forest Heights forbids the over expenditure of appropriated or transferred funds; and

**NOW, BE IT RESOLVED**, that funds be transferred from line item 7061 Public Safety Salary – Private 1 in the amount of \$11,400 to line item 8000 Street Repair Project in the amount of \$11,400, and from line item 7086 Public Works Crewman I in the amount of \$10,000, from line item 7087 Public Works Lead in the amount of \$5,000, from line item 7088 Public Works Crewman III in the amount of \$5,000, from line item 8038 Modoc Building in the amount of \$20,000, from 8009 Tree Releaf Grant Expense in the amount of \$7,400 and from line item 8031 Sustainable Forest Heights Plan in the amount of \$3,300 to line item 8018 North Huron Street Reconstruction in the amount of \$50,700.

**AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
