A RESOLUTION FOR EARLY PAYMENT FOR THE MAYOR

ENACTED: _____

WHEREAS, Section 33-5 (Salary) of the Town Charter reads that the Mayor shall receive an annual salary as set from time to time by an ordinance passed by the Council in the regular course of business; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.2: Compensation of the Mayor and Councilpersons states the Mayor shall receive salary of \$5,000 per year, payable monthly or unless otherwise prescribed by resolution of the Mayor and Town Council, therefore, the Council further finds at this time that the frequency of pay may be at intervals other than monthly and that the Council may by resolution modify such payment intervals including allowing for advance pay for individual elected officials if a hardship or other need arises

BE IT RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and that the Mayor should receive advance pay in the amount of \$2,000.00 immediately through June 2015.
