**A RESOLUTION TO DECLARE AND DISPOSE OF CERTAIN POLICE-ISSUED  
PERSONAL PROPERTY AS SURPLUS**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Forest Heights Town Code (Article 20) Financial Management and Internal Controls, §20.4 (Procedures) subsections ((a) 8, 9, & 10), the legislative body has incorporated the procedures to dispose of equipment; and

**WHEREAS**, a Town police officer is leaving the FHPD and he has asked that he be allowed to purchase his issues body armor, and Chief Russell has no objections since this piece of equipment is fitted to the each person and recommends that the Council consider selling the property to said departing officer for \$450.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the original price of the armor was about \$750.00 but it is now one (1) year old.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Town Council of Town of Forest Heights, Maryland hereby declares the above-described property to be surplus and it may be sold to the departing police officer for an amount of \$450.00.

**AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that this Resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
